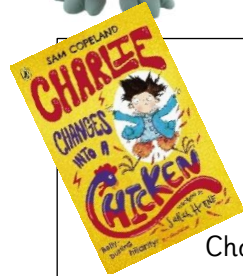
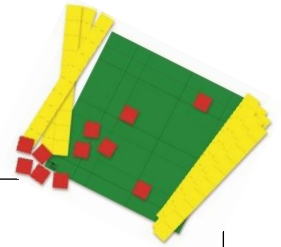

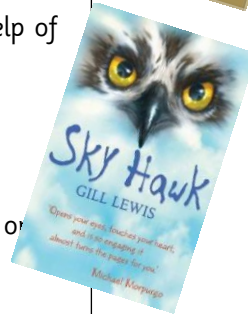

Our Writer's Toolkit:

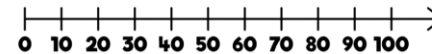
We will be building a narrative including using exciting adverbs (quickly, slowly) and adjectives (describing words). We will build on the children's use of the word because with subordinate clauses.



Maths

Place Value

We will be recognizing the value of each digit in 2 and 3 digit numbers, hundreds, tens and ones. We will compare numbers up to 1000 and order them using concrete apparatus, pictures and on a numberline. We will learn how to identify and represent numbers up to 1000 in lots of different ways.



Addition and Subtraction

We will begin by adding two and three digit numbers and ones, as well as three digit numbers and 10's. This should help us to add three digit numbers and 2 digit numbers successfully.
